Our College was re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade in 2013 and got its Autonomous Status in 2017.

The structure and positions such as Controller of Examinations and Member Secretary (Academics) are effectively functioning. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) which monitors quality sustenance and quality enhancement is actively functioning in our institution. The research centre of our institution is also actively functioning. So far, five research scholars have been awarded with doctoral degree and currently eight scholars are undergoing Ph.D.

Inauguration of SWAYAM-NPTEL Local Chapter
