The meeting of the academic council commenced with the college prayer, followed by the proceedings of the meeting.

The Principal *Dr. B. C. Sobha* introduced and welcomed the members of the academic council.

Leave of absence received from the University Nominees *Dr. Indira Rangasamy* (Principal, Government College of Education for Women, Coimbatore) *Dr. Meenakshi*, (Asst. Prof. in Education, Madurai Kamaraj University) and subject experts from outside the college *Dr. H. Indu* were recorded.

The Principal presented minutes / proceedings of the Second Academic Council Meeting.

3/2018 Confirmation of the Minutes of the First Academic Council Meeting

The minutes of the first academic council meeting held on 21th July 2017 was confirmed by the members of academic council.

The meeting resolved to record the confirmation of the minutes of the first academic council meeting.

4 / 2018 Curriculum Modifications / Suggestions for B.Ed., M. Ed. and M. Phil. Degree programme (with effect from the academic year 2018-2019)

The Member Secretary *Dr. K. Gireesh Kumar*, presented the curriculum framework and syllabus for the B.Ed., M.Ed. and M. Phil. degree programmes for the consideration of the Academic Council with effect from the academic year 2018-2019.

After careful review and elaborate discussions the members of the academic council suggested the following corrections and modifications for the **B.Ed. degree programme**.

Dr. C. P. Sreekandan Nair (*Subject Expert*) suggested the perspective course in the fourth semester '*Gender Justice and Inclusive Education*' should be read as ***Gender justice*** (one word).

The practical component in the second semester 'Construction of Achievement Test' the number of tests is to be specified clearly.

Dr. V. Reghu (*Subject Expert*) suggested the following modifications:

The role and responsibilities of the mentor teachers in the school during internship practice is to be specified.

The materials/journals published by UGC, NCERT are to be referred for preparing notes of lesson for value education classes and to conduct a workshop regarding it.

Workshop on any identified areas can be conducted in each semester to enhance the academic quality.

References on Modules are to be cited from websites and to visit some centre of excellences like Azim Premji University, Viswa Barathi University, etc.

As the part of quality enhancement programme, a report from the teaching faculty at the end of the semester on the innovations made can be done to promote quality of the institution.

In practical component 'Life Skills Education' and 'Social Project' are to be clubbed together as '***Life Skills related Projects***'.

Dr. G. Mohan Kumar (*Subject Expert*) recommended that models of different achievement tests are to be availed and a workshop on preparation of these tests can be conducted. New lesson plans are to be incorporated along with traditional methods.

Instead of models, templates can be given for preparing reflective reports and uniqueness in reporting for every student is to be promoted.

Many environmental related activities are to be included in the practical component 'Environmental Education' and separate evaluation format for multimedia kit is to be prepared as per the suggestions of **Dr. R. Mukundan** (Academic Advisor)

The meeting resolved to incorporate the suggested modifications in the curriculum and syllabus of the B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic year 2018-2019 and recommend to the College Governing Body.

Regarding **M.Ed. Curriculum** modifications suggested are the following:

Dr. C. P. Sreekandan Nair (*Subject Expert*) suggested the perspective course in the first semester 'Historical and Political Economy of Education' is to be re-named as '***History Politics and Economy of Education***'

As per **Dr. Reghu's** suggestion, the title of the course 'Advanced Educational Technology' is to be changed as '***Emerging Trends in Educational Technology***'.

List of abbreviations in each course are to be mentioned separately in the appendix page of the curriculum frame work.

The meeting resolved to incorporate the suggested modifications in the curriculum and syllabus of the M.Ed. programme with effect from the academic year 2018-2019 and recommend to the College Governing Body.
