REPORT: 2018-19

With the successful nearing to completion of the academic year 2018-19, our institution's IQAC has rebooted itself in designing, organizing and implementing quality educational activities which aimed at benefiting our student teacher community towards excellence by envisaging the glorified vision of Gnana, Dharma and Sneha. The gist of our academic ventures are summarized here with :

The Academic Year 2018-19 : A Glance

The academic year began on 16th July 2018.

- The first Statutory Meetings of Board of Studies, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body were held on 12th July, 21st July, 24th July and 31st July 2018 respectively. The second Statutory Meetings of Board of Studies and Academic Council, were held on 15th March and 27th April 2019 respectively. The other bodies would be held shortly.
- B.Ed. First year classes commenced on 16th July 2018. Dr. C.P. Sreekantan Nair and Dr. R. Mukundan, Academic Advisors of our college inaugurated the programme.
- On 24th July 2018, a special talk on “Teacher Plus” was conducted . Dr Damodaran, Former Principal, V.O.C. College of Education, Thoothukudi was the resource person.
- A Faculty Development Programme for Teacher Educators on “Creation of Blog” was conducted on 30th July 2018.

- The Intensive internship programme of B.Ed II year students was conducted for 16 weeks during their third semester from 30th July 2018 to 8th December 2018. The students were distributed to various co-operative schools to experience practice teaching.
- On 31st July 2018, a research colloquium on “Presentation of Research Tool” was conducted for M.Ed. IInd year.
- A Doctoral Committee Meeting was conducted on 1st August 2018 for the finalisation of research topic of our Ph.D. scholar Ms Rejee M.K. Nair under the Chairmanship of Dr. Sreekantan Nair, Former Principal, Farooq Training College, Calicut.
- Induction Programme was conducted from 6th to 8th August 2018 to orient the students towards teaching, to make them familiarize with the course content, and also to help them adjust with the new situations as the new entrants.
- Micro teaching classes were arranged from 30th August to 6th September 2018. These classes made the students learn various teaching skills. Video recording of the classes were also done to facilitate the students to evaluate their classes for their improvement.
- As part of Swatch Bharat Campaign, our B.Ed. students had undergone cleaning programme in Govt. High School, Tiruvattar on 26th September 2018. The students cleaned the school premises.
- Workshop on Dramatics was conducted for B.Ed. II year students from 27th September and 28th September 2018. Dr. Xavier Dhas, Associate Professor (Retd.), St.Jude’s College, Thoothoor was the resource person.

- A Capacity Building Programme named ‘Parivarthan’ for Teacher Educators was conducted from 27th September to 29th September 2018.
- The college witnessed election for the students’ council on 1st October 2018. College union was inaugurated on 24th November 2018 by Dr. Jeya Kumar, Associate Professor, Department of Botany, Nesamoni Memorial Christian College, Marthandam.
- On 6th October 2018, a Special Lecture on “Environmental Protection Initiatives in Swach Bharat “was organised. Dr V.M. Sasi Kumar, National Vice President, CTE; Dr.Madhuri Isave, Associate Professor, Tilak College of Education, Pune; and Taraivini N. Raiula, Lecturer, School of Education, College of Humanities and Education, Fiji National University, Fiji were the resource persons.
- To acquaint our students to the way of life of the community, a citizenship training camp was organized from 9th to 13th October 2018. The programme schedule was packed up with wide range of community linked activities .
- On 16th October 2018, a rally promoting Clean India Campaign-“Friends of Nature” was organized in association with Attoor Panchayat.
- Our library is richly equipped and technologically uplifted .It has a collection of 16819 books, 58 Indian and International journals and magazines, nine multilingual news dailies and Inflibnet N-list e-journals.

- Department of Library conducted Book exhibitions on 19th June and 14th November 2018. It was by TamilNadu Book House, Tirunelveli and Sai Book Gallery, Tirunelveli
- On 10th November 2018, an awareness programme on “Managing Diabetes” was organized by Saraswathy Hospital.
- Library week was celebrated from 14th November to 20th November 2018.
- A national workshop on ‘Plagiarism Detection: A Quality Index to Research Integrity’ was held on 5th January 2019 by the Department of Library.
- A national workshop on ‘Learning Initiatives of SWAYAM on MOOCs and Online Research Tools’ was conducted on 19th January 2019 by IQAC and the Department of Library.
- A Five-day educational trip to Delhi was arranged for the students from 1st to 9th February 2018. Our students, along with the staff members visited various places of educational significance in New Delhi, Agra and Amritsar.
- During National Science Day on February 28 2019, our B.Ed. students visited various schools and created scientific attitude among school students by demonstrating science experiments through improvised teaching aids.
- The internship programme for B.Ed I year students was conducted for 6 weeks during the second semester from 22nd January 2019 to 1st March, 2019. The students were distributed to various co-operative schools to experience practice teaching.
- A Women *Task Force* is functioning to redress the issues of the lady students.

- On 8th March 2019, Women's Day Celebration was held and in connection with it, a seminar on "Women Empowerment" in collaboration with Council for Teacher Education Kerala chapter and Common Wealth Council for Educational Administration and Management was organised. A panel discussion was also conducted in association with it. Various competitions were also conducted as part of International Women's Day Celebrations.
- Physical Science Club Meeting was conducted on 25th March 2019. The Chief Guest for the meeting was Ms S. Saranya, B.T. Assistant, Govt. High School, Kappicode. She gave a talk on "Science Teacher".
- Consumer Club meeting was conducted on 26th March 2019. The resource persons were Mr. Charles, President, Civil Consumer Protection and Civic Rights Association, Kulasekaram and Mr. Gopalakrishnan, Secretary, Civil Consumer Protection and Civic Rights Association, Kulasekaram.
- On 26th March 2019, Biological Science Club Meeting was conducted. The Chief Guest for the meeting was Dr K. Sheeba Beracah, Assistant Professor, Christian College of Education, Marthandam. She gave a talk on "Nurture our Nature for Better Future".
- Arts Day was conducted with all its vigour and vitality on 27th March 2019. The students from four different houses competed in a variety of competitions which showcased their creative talents.
- Mathematics Club Meeting was conducted on 28th March 2019. The Chief Guest for the meeting was Mr Suresh Kumar, B.T. Assistant, Govt. High School, Villunikonam. He gave a talk on "How to be an Effective Mathematics Teacher".

- The English and History clubs conducted a meeting on 28th March 2019. The resource person was Dr.B. Asha Kumari, Assistant Professor of English, Muslim Arts College. She gave a talk on ‘Necessity of English Language in day to day life’.
- An awareness programme on “Dental Care” was organised on 28th March 2019 by the Health Club. The resource person was Dr.S. Subramanian, Associate Professor, C.S.I Medical College, Karakonam.
- On 29th March 2019 a Rangoli competition was conducted to create Voting awareness was by Attoor Panchayath.
- The National Days such as Independence Day and Republic Day were celebrated on 15th August 2018 and 26th January 2019 respectively with all its national pride and patriotism. During these days, the freedom fighters were remembered for their sacrifice with gratitude. The celebration began in the college premises with the unfurling of the National flag, followed by a speech with patriotic zeal and fervour by the Principal.
- National Unity day, National Education day, National Handloom day and National Voters day were were also observed.
- The Career and Counselling Cell functioning in the college gives notifications on various job placements and also is directing the students to attend campus interviews to be recruited in various schools. This year, ABI Educational and Charitable Trust has facilitated to conduct a Campus

Interview by Brilliant CBSE School, Thanjavur were many of our students participated.

- Religious festivals like Christmas and Pongal were celebrated with all their pomp and glory. Onam was celebrated with high-spirited gaiety and fervor on 26th August 2018. The students celebrated and enjoyed the day with pookalam competition, Thiruvathirakali, Uriyadi, Vadamavali etc.
- Christmas celebration was held on 11th December 2018 with joy and gusto. The day was celebrated with all its religious fervour and the merry occasion was manifested with the sharing of gifts, conveying of Christmas messages and various other cultural programmes.
- The college magazine ‘Srishty’ and bi annual journal with ISSN number ‘Frontiers in Education and Research’ are released regularly.
- Our students were made to watch the ‘Live Telecast’ programme by the Honorable Prime Minister of India Sri. Narendra Modi regarding Examination Anxiety on 16th February 2018.
- Like every other year, this year also our students have participated in the Intercollegiate Cultural and Sports Competition at District and Zonal level conducted by Tamilnadu Teachers’ Education University.
- In the District level Sports competition held on 28th January 2019, our college Men and Women Team participated in the events. Men Team scored highest points as the District Champion.

- In the Zonal level Sports competition held on 4th February 2019, R.S. Ajay of B.Ed. I year got first place in Javelin Throw event.
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- Examination reforms and innovations in the form of Online Test, Open Book Examination were conducted to bring qualitative output.
- Academic excellence is the hallmark of a good institution and our results in the university examination and examinations under autonomous stream have made us proud.
- For the final year examinations held in May 2018 by Tamil Nadu Teachers' Education University, Chennai, our students proved their academic excellence. In the B.Ed. Examination for 2016-18 batch, out of 83 students who appeared, 78 passed out successfully. In M.Ed. Examination, out of the 5 students appeared, all passed successfully.
- The results of examination for the B.Ed. (2017-19) and M.Ed. (2017-19) of autonomous batch was impressive. For the first semester examination held in December 2018, out of 87 students who appeared, 85 students passed. 81 students secured first class and 4 students got distinction. For the second semester B.Ed. examination held in May 2018, out of 96 students appeared, 93 students passed. 72 students secured first class and 21 students got distinction.
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- For the second semester M.Ed. examination held in May 2018, out of 5 students who appeared, 4 students passed in first class. For the third semester examination held in December 2018, out of 96 students who appeared, 95 students passed. 82 students secured first class and 9 students got distinction. For the third semester M.Ed. examination held in December

2018, out of 5 students who appeared, all the 5 students passed with first class. For the first semester M.Ed. examination held in December 2018, out of 2 students appeared, all passed with first class. .

- For the first semester M.Phil. examination held in December 2018, one student appeared and secured first class.
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- Infrastructure Augmentation: To ensure better teaching-learning environment, more infrastructural facilities were added in our laboratories and library. Books and Journals were also added to the stock of the library to supplement more learning
- Renovation and Repair: The cabin of the Controller of Examination was renovated comfortably and conveniently to accommodate the requirement of the position. Toilets and rest rooms of the staff and the students were renovated as per the requirement. Further, the office equipments were also refurbished on time.
- Office Equipment: Instructional and laboratory equipments were repaired. A fire safety system was also installed to ensure safe protection of campus from any fire mishap
