With the nearing to completion of the academic year 2019-20 infected with Sars-Cov19, our institution's IQAC has also initiated steps to regain academic zest and zeal by mooting enthusiasm back on track which targeted at benefiting our student teacher community towards excellence by envisaging the glorified vision of Gnana, Dharma and Snehabhy strictly safeguarding the safety of its stakeholders by promoting social distancing and following the Stay home, stay safe campaign. The gist of our academic ventures are summarized here with :

The Academic Year 2019-20

The regular and the usual activities of the various courses offered by our institution rolled on smoothly as per the pre-determined schedule till the outbreak of the pandemic. Here, at this juncture the IQAC is initiating an attempt to recapitulate the highlights of the activities undergone during this academic year.

The Highlights

- The One day international multidisciplinary webinar on Technology amidst Covid 19 pandemic; an initiative to evolve resources was conducted in collaboration with the council for Educational Administration and Management (CEAM) Tamilnadu chapter on June 4, 2020. Dr. Arun Kumar Goswamy, Professor and chairman Department of Political Science and Director South

Asian study circle, Jaganatha University, Dhaka, Bangladesh and Dr.Deki C Gyamtco, Professor, Paro College of Education, Royal University of Bhutan were the international speakers on the occasion. The webinar was coloured with the presence of renowned educationists and delegates across the globe

- We have started offering technologically enhanced online learning through the online portal of SWAYAM's National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning(NPTEL) by launching its local chapter in our institution on 19 December 2019 where the students and staff are opened with the possibilities of enrolling themselves with the various courses twice in a year.
- The festivals are always a means of uniting People. With this motive ,we have also organised a Food Fest on 22 November 2019 by showcasing a myriad variety of delicious homemade cuisines.
- Diabetes Awareness programme was conducted on 11 November 2019. The a team of expert medicos from SaraswathyHospital,Parassalai,sharedtheir expertise on the need for prioritising a healthy stay.
- Vigilance awareness week was celebrated from 5 November 2019 to sensitise our students towards commitment to promotion of integrity and righteousness in public life through citizen participation.
- Awareness on Pain and palliative care was initiated on 30 October 2019 to instil a sense of humanitarian approach and to provide

logistic assistance to humankind especially to those who are in dire need .

- Orientation classes for UGC NET and other competitive examinations were organised on different days. The classes held is expected to help the students to confidently approach the examination.
- Poster Competition with the theme "say no to plastic " was held on 23 October 2019. The various posters and charts depicted the different strategies and measures to eliminate and stop pollution. Our students enthusiastically participated in the competition which specifically reveals their consciousness in bring out ecological sustainability
- An Online quiz on English Language and Literature was conducted by the Department of English during the lockdown days .The department of physical Education also conducted an online quiz on Yoga during those days.
- The Intensive internship programme of B.EdI year students was conducted during their second semester from the mid of January through the first week of February. The students were distributed to various co-operative schools to experience practice teaching.
- Micro teaching classes were arranged from 26th August to six days during this year. These classes made the students learn various teaching skills. Video recording of the classes were also done to facilitate the students to evaluate their classes for their improvement.

- The college witnessed election for the students' council on 3rd October 2019. The College union was inaugurated on 11th November 2019.
- To acquaint our students to the way of life of the community, a citizenship training camp was organized from 17th to 21st September 2019. The programme schedule was packed up with wide range of community linked activities .
- Our library is richly equipped and technologically uplifted .It has a collection of 16819 books, 58 Indian and International journals and magazines, nine multilingual news dailies and Inflibnet N-list e-journals.
- Department of Library conducted Book exhibitions on 30 August and 2 October 2019
- As part of Diabetes awareness endeavour, we have conducted a Diabetes Awareness quiz on 11 November 2019.
- A Five-day educational trip to Hyderabad was arranged for the students from in March 2020. Our students, along with the staff members visited various places of educational significance in Hyderabad.
- During National Science Day on February 28 2020, our B.Ed. students visited various schools and created scientific attitude among school students by demonstrating science experiments through improvised teaching aids.
- A Women *Task Force* is functioning to redress the issues of the lady students.

- On 8th March 2020 , Women's Day was celebrated with various competition .
- The National Days such as Independence Day and Republic Day were celebrated on 15th August 2018 and 26th January 2019 respectively with all its national pride and patriotism. During these days, the freedom fighters were remembered for their sacrifice with gratitude. The celebration began in the college premises with the unfurling of the National flag, followed by a speech with patriotic zeal and fervour by the Principal.
- National Unity day, National Education day, Dr AP.J.AbdulKalam's Birthday and Gandhi Jayanthi were celebrated.
- Teachers Day was celebrated on 5 September 2019. In the day ,platforms were provided for the students to reminisce over their gurus.
- The Career and Counselling Cell functioning in the college gives notifications on various job placements and also is directing the students to attend campus interviews to be recruited in various schools. This year, our college facilitated to conduct a Campus Interviews were many of our students participated and got selection.
- Religious festivals like Christmas and Pongal were celebrated with all their pomp and glory. Onam was celebrated with high-spirited gaiety and fervor. The students celebrated and enjoyed the day with pookalam competition, Thiruvathirakali, Uriyadi, Vadamavali etc.
